

## **Lewine Global Engagement Fund**

The Lewine Global Engagement Fund will be used to enhance SUNY Brockport's efforts to build a generation of leaders and innovators who have a deep understanding of other cultures through international experiences and global engagement. The Lewine Family has committed to a gift of \$300,000 over the next five years. The funds will be used to support the following areas:

- 1. Global Business Leadership Program Collaborative study abroad program with a service learning component between the Center for Global Education & Engagement and the School of Business and Management. Students learn about corporate social responsibility and global engagement within the framework of an international experience. This program will be led by a faculty or staff member from the SOBAM and be available to any student at SUNY Brockport regardless of major. Funds provided will help defray the cost of participation.
- 2. <u>Global Education and Engagement Scholarships</u> provide scholarships that will support Brockport students who 1.) Participate in study abroad experiences and 2.) International students attending SUNY Brockport.
- 3. Outstanding Global Engagement Awards in recognition of both Dr. Victor Rojas and in memory of Dr. Francisco Zayas. Designed to encourage and recognize outstanding faculty and professional staff who advance internationalization and global engagement efforts in teaching and learning. On an annual basis, faculty and staff will apply or be nominated for funding of up to \$10,000 to support an activity or program of their design that promotes and supports the College's global education efforts and initiatives.
